  - a. Find out who your local, state, and federal representatives are here.<sup>1</sup>
  - b. Watch or read the news and find one issue that makes you happy/sad/angry and write to your representatives about it.

- 5. Sharing
  - a. Check out how people are using platforms like TikTok to talk about injustice in their world <u>here</u>
